Thank you letter from St Theodosius parish was read by Basil Kochan. Restoration will mostly be covered by insurance but will need \$400,000-\$500,000 more. They have already raised about 200,000 through generous donations. Prayers are most welcome. 2-3 years forecasted for completion. St Nicholas parish had a dessert auction to benefit St Theodosius parish and raised \$8,000.

There will be a Health and Retirement fair on October 14.

- OCW: book study is on Journey to Reality Zachary Porcu. It starts October 8, and will be held every Tuesday, in the mornings, skipping election day, and in the evenings by Fr James Leaks via ZOOM.
- Clergy Association: A combined Liturgy of all the Akron, Orthodox parishes will be celebrated Saturday April 26, 2025 of Bright Week. It will be at St Nicholas at 10:00. Bring foods to share with your own ethnic flair. Basil Kochan asked Fr Nick to have Clergy Association share this with their choir directors.
- St Nick said FOCA (Fellowship of Orthodox Christians in America) has an annual Christmas choir production. He suggested all parishes in COCA

- create a 2-3 Christmas choir video. Basil Encouraging Orthodox hymns and some chanting opposed to the secular carols. There is a Google link to Fellowship of Orthodox Christians in America on YouTube. Need video by week before Christmas. Fr Nick encouraged videos with children singing.
- October 7th The Miraculous Icon of Tikhvin will return to St Nicholas at 7:00pm with Akathist.
- John Bober provided a handout to share on the objective of COCA and what we should be focusing on. COCA promotes fellowship, publicizes events, and encourages greater attendance, etc.
- Effective Parish Assessment by Orthodox Ministry Services was discussed. It is a free service offered by Bill Marianes who is associated with OCA Ministry Services. Any parish can do this. It is a multi question online assessment that any parishioner fills out. Orthodox Ministry then scores it and lumps it into 6 major pillars. It tells where your strong and weak points are. John strongly encourages all parishes of COCA to do this and we share our results with each other. This ministry has been in existence since 2022. There are podcasts describing this. Each podcast lasts about 2 hours. Approx 50–55 parishes have done this in the US.
- Debbie Morgan presents a flier for Faith and Blue October 5th at
 Hardesty Park 11-2pm. The Presentation of our Lord is planning on
 having a booth. Debbie Morgan suggests COCA join them. Everyone agreed,
 COCA should be present.
- Clergy Association priests support an Orthodox school, (St Constantine) in Akron.
